## **STANDING STONES DRESS CODE**

*Modest is hottest.* The Dress Code is nothing new to Standing Stones Camp and we will be enforcing it once again this year! We totally get it--gotta post the fit on TikTok, the weather is too hot, and/or maybe it's hard finding these clothes in today's fashion. However, we encourage you to follow these dress code guidelines in order to help us create a safe, comfortable, and modest environment! If you happen to have a question, ask your chaperone or ask a staff member!

Dresses and skirts must at least be knee length including the solid fabric piece/slip underneath mesh dresses. Slits cannot be above the knee.

Leggings, yoga pants, and biker shorts must be worn with a shirt that covers both the back and the front of pelvic areas.

Dark colored apparel for water activities.

Shorts must be fingertip length when arms are resting normally at sides.

No torn jeans and tops.

Wear running shoes for regular, non-water related activities.

No hats in the chapel. Anywhere else is fine.

NO clothes with inappropriate language/images.

All tank tops should be at least two fingertips wide.



No exposure of unnecessary skin or undergarments (ex: deep-cut shirts exposing chest area, muscle tees/tanks exposing side/chest area, crop tops, or undergarments such as boxers and sports bras. No cross dressing allowed.

## **STANDING STONES CAMP RULES**

At Standing Stones Camp, you can expect to take on a spiritual summer adventure deepening your relationship with Christ, meeting new friends (and old!), fellowshipping with your peers, and having some good ol' fun. But wait [there's the catch!], rules and guidelines do apply so every camper, volunteer, chaperone, group leader, and staff can make the most of their experience as you adhere to these safety guidelines. Camp rules apply to ALL Standing Stones participants.

#### **GENERAL CAMP RULES:**

• Respect yourselves, your peers, all camp staff and volunteers, and Southwest Baptist University campus authority (Note: Campus authority/security may be armed).

• Dress modestly at all times with respect to yourself and others. (Learn more below)

• If there is a non-emergency but urgent matter, immediately notify the closest staff, security, nurse, or chaperone.

• No alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco products, smoking, or E-cigs while on campus.

- No firearms, weapons, and fireworks.
- No use of profanity, bullying, and fighting.
- No public display of affection (PDA).
- No boys allowed in the girl's sleeping area and no girls allowed in the boys sleeping area.

• No leaving campus without permission by staff.

• No skateboards, skate shoes, and scooters.

### Any violation of the rules will not be tolerated and may result in removal from camp.
